

> TWENTY-ONE YEARS AGO, Avery Fisher introduced America's first high fidelity radio-phonograph. That instrument attained instant recognition as heralding a new era in the enjoyment of reproduced music. A number of the features of that early high fidelity radio-phonograph were so basic that they are used to this day in all high fidelity equipment. The engineering achievements of Avery Fisher and the world-wide reputation of his products have been the subject of articles in Fortune, Time, Pageant, The New York Times, Coronet, Life, High Fidelity, Esquire, High Fidelity Trade News and other publications.






The exclusive Quadribeam Tuning Indicator, for example, makes accurate tuning on both FM and AM extremely simple. The three high fidelity speakers operate with extreme efficiency, being matched to the acoustic characteristics of the speaker enclosure. The electrical crossover network includes Brilliance and presence controls on the front panel to achieve perfect balance. A strikingly effective Loudness Contour Control compensates for the normal loss of hearing efficiency at low volume settings by maintaining proper balance, even at such settings. The tone controls have facilities for independently cutting or boosting bass and treble tone intensity. The instrument can be adjusted to meet exactly the acoustic requirements of the room in which it is placed.


